# Do I Need a Permit to remove a nuisance animal?

You may not realize it, but that nuisance animal in your attic, shed, garage, or on your property might be legally protected in Illinois. Most wildlife is protected by law and cannot be killed or even removed without a Nuisance Animal Removal Permit. Most mice, moles, gophers, and ground squirrels can be removed without a permit. Raccoons, skunks, opossums, foxes, coyotes, rabbits, and most fur-bearing animals need a Permit for trapping and removal.
