SENIOR TAX FREEZE FOR NIAN TIC & HARRISTOWN TAXPAYERS

A clinic on property tax exemption for seniors is planned for May 9th from 1:30 to 3:00 PM at the Harristown Township Hall – 195 N. Meridian. To qualify, the person must be at least 65 years of age, live in their own home, with a household income of \$65,000 or less. Federal tax return for 2022 and all supporting 1099 forms for everyone living in the home are required.
