Please Be considerate of your neighbors when burning yard waste. Only Burn during daylight hours, with someone watching the fire. Don't burn in the roadway or streets. Don't burn if the yard waste is wet, it can create visibility hazards and can affect residents with breathing issues. ONLY YARD WASTE may be burned.



Brush Collection will be November 14th

Remember All yard waste needs to be in Bags. All branches need to be cut into 4 foot or less lengths. Brush pick-up is intended for branches removed during routine trimming or due to storm damage. This will be the last pickup before winter.
