## **CLEAN UP TIME**

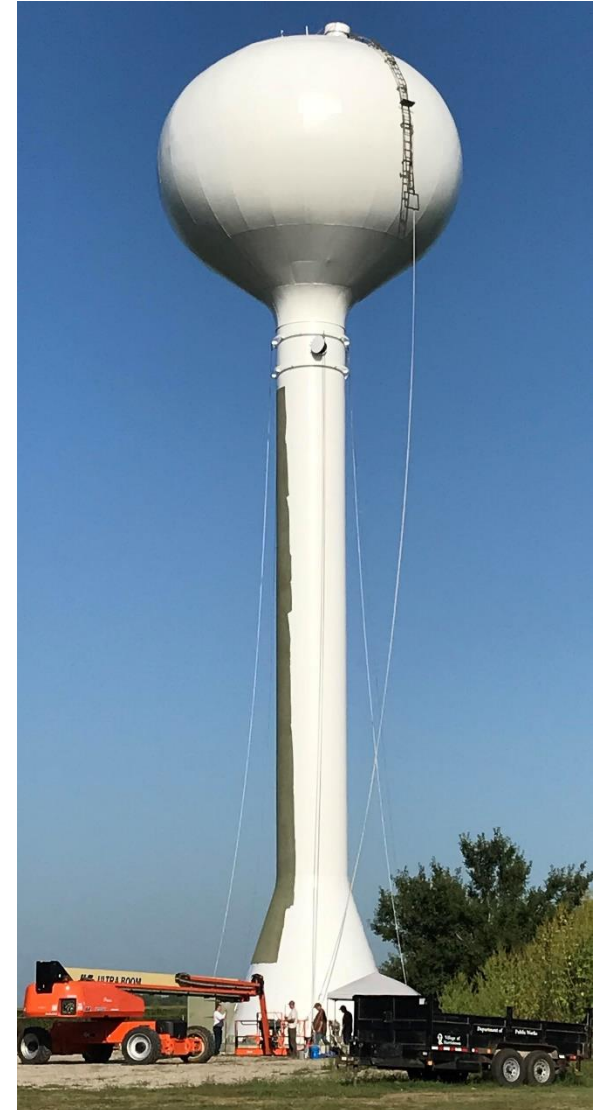
