# JULIE flag Removal

You may remove the JULIE flags in your yard only **IF** the digging has ended on your road.

The company is only running conduit down one side of the roadway. Most of the digging work, for now, has been completed in Old Harristown and between Meridian and Briarwood. The company still must run the fiberoptic cable through the installed conduit so you will see workers again eventually.



## Brush Collection September 12th

Remember all yard waste needs to be in bags. All branches need to be cut into **4 foot or less** lengths. Brush pick-up is intended for branches removed during routine trimming or due to storm damage.

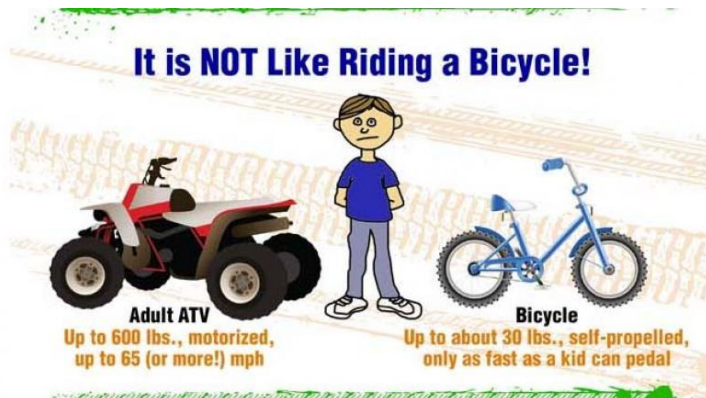


## KNOW BEFORE YOU RIDE

All persons living or visiting any residence must abide by village, county, and state laws regarding the use of ATV vehicles (ie, dirt bikes, 4 wheelers, side by sides, etc...). We have received several complaints of people riding carelessly on village roadways, not obeying stop signs, and excessive speeds on village streets. **This poses a very real danger not only for the rider(s) but also for anyone that shares the roadway with them.**

These actions violate both Village ordinances and Illinois State law "It is unlawful to operate an ATV or UTV on any street, highway or roadway in Illinois. You may cross a roadway at an angle of approximately 90 degrees where quick and safe crossing is available. Before crossing a street, you must come to a complete stop and yield the right of way to any pedestrian or vehicle. If you are crossing a divided highway, you may only cross at an intersection."

**If you have children riding, please make sure they know how to ride safely and the rules of the road.**
